Volunteers will be asked to undergo breath testing which involves collecting breath samples after drinking a small amount of lactulose.

You may qualify to participate if you are:

- Over the age of 18
- Not pregnant at the time of the study
- Have not taken antibiotics in the past 30 days
- Have not undergone a colonoscopy in the past 30 days
